1. Scales: one major AND one minor three octave scales of your choice
2. Solo: your solo should be representative of your overall musical and technical ability. Solo should be no more than 1 minutes in length.
3. Excerpt: Norman Leyden - Serenade for String Orchestra
Cakewalk
4. Sight Reading: Don't neglect practicing sight reading pieces you are unfamiliar with to help prepare for this part of the audition.
